 Here are four powerful, connected verses on **God's love and mercy**, starting with Lamentations:

Lamentations 3:22-23 "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness."

Psalms 103:8 "The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love."

Ephesians 2:4-5 "But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ - by grace you have been saved."

1 John 4:9 "In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent His only Son into the world, so that we might live through Him."

The Bridge: How His Mercies Stay New

The Cost of the Fresh Start

- *Lamentations* promises that God's mercies are brand new every morning.
- *Communion* reminds us why this is spiritually possible.

A Daily Table

- Just like the morning sunrise brings new mercy, the broken body and spilled Blood of Jesus provide a permanent table of grace.
- You do not have to be "perfect" to come to this table; you just have to be hungry for His mercy.

The Communion Transition

"Family, as we take the bread and the cup today, we are doing this to remember Him. If you are struggling with depression, anxiety, or a heavy heart this morning, look at these elements.

- *The bread represents His body, broken so you could be made whole.*
- *The cup represents His blood, shed so your past is completely wiped clean.*

Every time you take communion, you are stepping into the reality of Lamentations. You are receiving a fresh, tangible supply of the Father's mercy.

Let us pause for a second and remember His sacrifice, and receive His fresh grace right now."
