

The meaning of *another* and *the two witnesses*

1. The Hidden Counterfeit: *Allos* vs. *Heteros* (The Two Words for "Another")

In English, we just have the word "another." But classical Greek has two distinct digital keywords that mean completely different things.

- **The Greek Definitions:**
 - ἄλλος (*allos*): Means "**another of the exact same kind.**" (For example: If you eat an apple, and ask for *allos* apple, as in you want another apple, not a banana).
 - ἕτερος (*heteros*): Means "**another of a completely different kind.**" (This is where we get the word *hetero-sexual* or *hetero-geneous*).
- **How Jesus Uses *Allos*:** When Jesus promises to *send the Holy Spirit* in John 14:16, He says, "I will pray the Father, and He will give you **another** (*allos*) Helper." Jesus is saying, "I am sending you someone who is *exactly like Me* - divine, holy, and loving."
- **How the Beast Uses *Allos*:** Now look at Revelation 13:11 when the False Prophet appears: "Then I saw **another** (*allos*) beast coming up out of the earth." John uses *allos* on purpose! He is telling us that the False Prophet is *of the exact same demonic nature* as the first Beast.
- **The Visual Deception:** The text says this second beast "had two horns like a lamb but spoke like a dragon." He *looks* like a gentle lamb (*mimicking Christ*), but because his nature is *allos* (*the same as the first monster*), his words are pure satanic deception. He is a counterfeit Holy Spirit, pointing everyone to worship the Antichrist.

2. The Power Sources: The Two Olive Trees (Revelation 11:4)

When John describes the Two Witnesses in Revelation 11, he drops a cryptic architectural keyword, calling them "the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before the God of the earth."

- **The Old Testament Blueprint:** To understand this, your keyword eye has to jump back to Zechariah chapter 4. Zechariah saw a vision of a golden lampstand flanked by two olive trees. The olive trees were constantly emptying fresh oil directly into the bowls of the lampstand through golden pipes so the light would never go out.
- **The Symbolism of Oil:** In scripture, oil is the universal keyword for the **Holy Spirit**.
- **The Analytical Meaning:** In Zechariah's day, the two olive trees represented the two anointed leaders of Israel: Joshua the High Priest (religious leader) and Zerubbabel the Governor (civil leader). God told them that rebuilding the temple wouldn't happen by human military might, but "By My Spirit" (Zechariah 4:6).
- **The Revelation Application:** By calling the Two Witnesses the "Two Olive Trees," John is revealing their internal power source. During the Tribulation, these two men will not be operating on human energy, political strategy, or adrenaline. They are literally plugged directly into the reservoir of the Holy Spirit. They are an unstoppable, self-sustaining spiritual power plant on the earth, which is why the forces of the Antichrist cannot touch them until their 1,260-day mission is completely finished.
