

Healing for the Whole Man

Introduction

The principles of divine healing, although not always explicitly stated, are interwoven throughout the Scriptures as an integral part of God's redemptive plan. According to Romans 5:12, the entrance of sickness and death into the world is attributable to the original sin of Adam. It follows that, just as the fruit of a tree cannot live when the root is destroyed, God's redemptive solution for the root problem — sin — includes its fruit — sickness.

This "double cure" principle — forgiveness and the remission of sin as well as divine healing — is evidenced by the linking of forgiveness and healing throughout Scripture (Exod. 15:23-26; Num. 21:4-9; Ps.103:3; Isa. 53:4,5; James 5:14-16; 1 Peter 2:24). Jesus answered the question, "Which is easier, to forgive sin or heal disease?" by demonstrating both forgiveness and healing as God's chosen Redeemer (Luke 5:17-24).

We must remember that the doctrinal basis for divine healing is redemption; therefore divine healing is for all who will receive it! God is no respecter of persons; healing is not reserved for a favored few (Acts 10:34). All of His blessings are a part of the restorative work wrought through Christ's death, burial, and resurrection (2 Cor. 1:20).

Healing is a part of Christ's atoning work! Our healing was purchased in our redemption. But all the blessings of God's great salvation (His redeeming power for the whole man — spirit, soul, and body) are received "by grace through faith" (Eph. 2:8). Jesus said in the context of healing: ". . . all things are possible to him that believeth" (Mark 9:23).

When we are faithful to believe and act on His promises, He is faithful to perform them (Ps. 57:1,2)! The more specific we are in our believing, the more specific God can be in bringing to pass the resulting answer. First John 5:14,15 says, "... if we ask any thing according to his will... we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him."

Faith for asking and receiving comes from hearing God's Word (Rom. 10:17). Therefore specific faith for healing comes from hearing and meditating on God's healing Word (Ps. 107:20; Prov. 4:20-22). Where the Bible is not specific, we can't be. But we can and should be as specific in our believing as the Scripture is concerning God's will. "We having the same spirit of FAITH, according as it is WRITTEN, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also BELIEVE, AND THEREFORE SPEAK (2 Cor. 4:13; see also Acts 26:22; Rev. 22:18,19).

Because the benefits of redemption are received through faith, in order to be fully persuaded concerning God's will, we must answer the question: "How interested is God in the specific day-to-day needs of our bodies?"

Faith begins where the will of God is known! In this book, Healing for the Whole Man, I hope to demonstrate how God has proven in His Word — His will — the tremendous extent of His concern and care for our physical bodies, as well as His willingness to manifest that concern and care in healing power for any and every part of our bodies that we will believe his redemption includes!

As we meditate on the foundational healing scriptures (Part I), with verses relating to our specific area of need (Part II by parts of the body; Part III by illness), faith can arise to receive that specific healing (Mark 11:22-24; Joshua 1:8; Prov. 4:20-23). May this brief study guide assist you to that end.

As we begin our study in the Word, we must be careful not to "... [handle] the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth . . . [commend] ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God" (2 Cor. 4:2). Neither should we "wrest or twist the Scriptures to our own destruction" (2 Peter 3:16). Rather, we are to do as the Word instructs: "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15).

In order to rightly divide the Word, we must approach the Scriptures prayerfully, opening our hearts to the Holy Spirit — the Spirit of Truth — who is our Teacher and Guide. We must also keep in mind the following principles of Bible interpretation:

- 1. Although a scripture will have a specific meaning within its historical context, the spiritual truth of that verse could have varied applications for us today. Second Timothy 3:16 says, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness."
- 2. Revelation is progressive. In other words, glimmers of scriptural truth in Old Testament types and shadows become increasingly clear and bright as we proceed through the Gospels and into the Epistles (Eph. 3:3-5; Col. 1:25,26; John 16:12,13; 1 Peter 1:10-12).

The New Testament is the definitive commentary of the Old Testament, and the Holy Spirit is the ultimate authority on proper context, meaning, and application. Only through the revealing power of the Spirit of Truth, who authored the written Word of Truth, can we receive the knowledge of the truth! (2 Peter 1:19-21; 1 Cor. 2:9-16; Eph. 1:8,9,17,18; Col. 1:9, et al. See also, John chapter 5, especially verses 39 and 40; and John 8, especially verses 43 and 44.)

Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think — infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes or dreams —

To Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever. Amen — so be it.

Abdomen (Belly/Intestines/Stomach/Etc.)

Proverbs 3:8 ... [God's law] shall be health [Hebrew: "medicine"] to thy navel. ...

Proverbs 18:20 A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth. . . .

Deuteronomy 28:27; Gal. 3:13 (Various translations read: ulcers, hemorrhoids, piles, swellings in the groin.)

Acts 28:8,9 (Father of Publius healed of a "bloody flux," i.e., dysentery or bloody diarrhea.)

Back

Leviticus 21:18-23 (A crookback or hunchback was not acceptable for an Old Testament priest of God. Neither should believers, who are New Testament priests unto God, accept back problems, or any weakness, sickness, or disease.)

Luke 13:11-16 (Jesus said she ought to be loosed, or made straight.)

Blood

Joel 3:21 For I will cleanse their blood....

Ezekiel 16:6 And when I. . . saw thee polluted in thine own blood, I said. . . Live.

Mark 5:29 And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague. (cf. Lev. 17:11,14; Prov. 4:20-23.)

Bones

Proverbs 3:8 . . . [God's law] shall be health [Hebrew: "medicine"] to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

Isaiah 58:11 And the Lord shall. . . make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Psalm 34:19,20 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all. He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken.

Acts 3:6,7 ... In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk... and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. (cf. 2 Kings 13:21; Job 10:11,12; Jer. 20:9; Ezek. 37:3,4,7; Prov. 12:4; 14:30; 15:30; 17:22.)

Digestion

Psalm 22:26 The meek shall EAT and be SATISFIED. . . .

Mark 16:18 ... if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them. ...

Matthew 15:17 ... whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?

Ecclesiastes 3:13 ... that every man should eat and drink, and enjoy. . . is the gift of God.

Ears

Proverbs 20:12 The hearing ear... the Lord hath made....

Isaiah 35:5 ... the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

Isaiah 32:3 ... the ears of them that hear shall hearken. (cf. Isa. 42:18; 50:4,5; Matt. 13:16; Luke 22:50,51.)

Eyes

Proverbs 20:12 ... the seeing eye, the Lord hath made. ...

Psalm 146:8 The Lord openeth the eyes of the blind. . . .

Isaiah 35:4,5 ... he [God] will come and save you. Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened....

Isaiah 29:18 And in that day. . . the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity, and out of darkness.

Isaiah 32:3 And the eyes of them that see shall not be dim. . . .

Deuteronomy 34:7 And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.

Matthew 13:16 ... blessed are your eyes, for they see. ... (cf. Lev. 26:16; Deut. 28:32,65; Gal. 3:13 — we are redeemed from the curse of failing eyes.)

Feet

1 Samuel 2:9 He will keep the feet of his saints. . . .

Psalm 91:11,12 ... he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Psalm 121:3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved. . . .

Proverbs 3:23,26 Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble. For the Lord shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being taken.

Acts 3:7 ... his feet and ankle bones received strength.

Acts 14:8,10 ... there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet... a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked.... [Paul] said... Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.

Habakkuk 3:19 The Lord God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. . . . (cf. Deut. 28:35; Gal. 3:13; Ps. 22:16; Exod. 21:24.)

Proverbs 4:22 For they [God's words] are life. . . and health [Hebrew: "medicine"] to all their flesh.

- "health for the entire body" (Jerusalem translation)

- "they mean real life for you and radiant health" (Taylor's paraphrase)

Job 33:24,25 ... I have found a ransom [Hebrew: "atonement"]. His flesh shall be fresher than a child's: he shall return to the days of his youth.

Ezekiel 37:6 And I will... bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, ... and ye shall live....

2 Corinthians 4:11 ... the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh.

Daniel 1:15 (The Hebrew children were "fairer and fatter in flesh.")

Jeremiah 32:27 Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?

(cf. Luke 22:50,51; 24:39; Eph. 5:23-32.)

Groin

Deuteronomy 28:27 (Knox and Jerusalem Bibles translate "emerods": swellings in the groin; Gal. 3:13 — Christ has redeemed us!)

Proverbs 31:17 (The virtuous woman girdeth her loins with strength.)

Ephesians 6:14 ... having your loins girt about with truth....

See also: Abdomen/Legs/Reproductive System (this section).

Gums

See: Mouth (this section).

Hair

Luke 21:18 [Jesus said]. . . there shall not an hair of your head perish.

Luke 12:7 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. . . .

2 Samuel 14:11 ... there shall not one hair of thy son fall to the earth.

2 Samuel 25,26 (Absalom's hair weighed between five and seven pounds annually).

(cf. 1 Sam. 14:45; 1 Kings 1:52; Dan. 3:27,28; Acts 27:34; Song of Sol. 4:1; 6:5; 7:5; Ezek. 16:7,14; Isa. 3:24; 46:4; Prov. 16:31; 20:29.)

Hands

Deuteronomy 33:7 And this is the blessing of Judah. . . let his hands be sufficient for him.

Job 4:3 ... hast strengthened the weak hands.

Nehemiah 6:9 ... O God, strengthen my hands.

Psalm 144:1 Blessed be the Lord my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, and my fingers to fight.

Isaiah 41:13 For I the Lord thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.

Isaiah 35:3 Strengthen ye the weak hands....

Mark 3:3,5 ... he [Jesus] saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other. (cf. Hosea 7:15.)

Immune System

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Psalm 91:5-10 Thou shalt not be afraid... for the PESTILENCE.... A thousand may fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.... There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any PLAGUE come nigh thy dwelling.

Exodus 11:7 (God made a distinction between Hebrews and Egyptians in that He was an invisible shield or barrier of protection for them.)

Psalm 3:3 But thou, O Lord, art a SHIELD for me; my GLORY, and the lifter up of mine head.

Isaiah 4:4,5 . . . the Lord shall have. . . purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof. . . . And the Lord will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion . . . a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the GLORY shall be a DEFENCE.

Deuteronomy 28:61; Gal. 3:13 (Christ has redeemed us from kidney disease.)

Knees

Job 4:4 ... hast strengthened the feeble [bowing] knees.

Isaiah 35:3 (God commands us to strengthen and confirm the feeble knees.)

Hebrews 12:12 (Let the feeble knees be healed!)

Deuteronomy 28:35; Gal. 3:13 (Christ has redeemed us from knee problems.) (cf. Song of Sol. 7:1.)

See also: Legs (this section) and Arthritis (Part III).

Legs

Isaiah 35:6 Then shall the lame man leap as an hart....

1 Samuel 2:4 ... they that stumbled are girded with strength.

Zechariah 10:12 And I will strengthen them in the Lord; and they shall walk up and down in his name, saith the Lord.

Hebrews 12:13 ... make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.

Deuteronomy 28:35; Gal. 3:13 (Christ has redeemed us from leg problems.) (cf. Song of Sol. 5:15; 7:1.)

Lips

See: Mouth (this section).

Liver

Deuteronomy 28:22; Gal. 3:13 ("Mildew" is translated jaundice by the Fenton Bible.) Christ has redeemed us from liver disease.

See also: Abdomen/Blood/Flesh/Immune System (this section) and Inflammation/Jaundice/Poisoning (Part III).

Lungs

See: Respiratory System (this section).

Mouth (Gums/Lips/Taste Buds/Tongue)

Psalm 103:5 Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things. . . .

Proverbs 12:18,19 ... the tongue of the wise is health. The lip of truth shall be established for ever....

Proverbs 8:6-8 ... the opening of my lips shall be right things.

Psalm 51:15 ... my mouth shall shew forth thy praise.

Job 6:6,30 (Taste is often mentioned in Scripture, not only for pleasure, but also to discern what is good and what is spoiled or dangerous to eat.)

Deuteronomy 28:27,61; Gal. 3:13 (Christ has redeemed us from ulcers, sores and from all disease of the mouth, lips, tongue, and gums — Young's and Rother-ham's translations.)

(cf. Prov. 24:13; Num. 11:8; Exod. 16:31; Ps. 34:8; 119:103; Song of Sol. 4:3,11; 7:9.)

See also: Digestion/Teeth (this section) and Speech Disorders (Part III).

Muscles

See: Flesh/Sinews/Skin/Specific Part of the Body Affected (this section) and Paralysis (Part III).

Neck

Isaiah 10:27 ... the [oppressor's] yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing. (cf. Isa. 52:1,2; Ps. 3:3; 27:1-6; Prov. 29:1; Song of Sol. 4:4; 7:4.)

Nervous System (Brain)

(The brain fulfills the function of governing by means of communication. Messages and words of command are sent and received by means of electrochemical energy transfer. In a sense, nerves are pathways of light. Nervous diseases are often such strongholds because they are so closely connected with obvious manifestations of the kingdom of darkness.)

John 1:5 His life is the light that shines through the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it (*Taylor*'s paraphrase)!

- 2 Thessalonians 3:1 ... that the word of the Lord [master, governor] may have free course....
- "may run" (Authorized Standard Version)
- "may speed on" (*Moffatt*'s translation)
- "may go forward unhindered" (J.B. Phillips' translation)

Proverbs 12:28 In the way of righteousness is life: and in the pathway thereof there is no death. (cf. Job 19:8.)

Isaiah 58:8,12 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily. . . . And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in. (cf. Isa. 58:11.)

Luke 1:37;18:27; Mark 9:23; Jer. 32:27 (Men say it is impossible for nerve cells or brain cells to be regenerated. But the things that are impossible with men are possible with God. "All things are possible to him that believes!")

Deuteronomy 28:61; Gal. 3:13 (Christ has redeemed us from every disease.) (cf. Prov. 4:18; Ps. 97:4,11; 119:130.)

Nose

Genesis 2:7 ... and [the Lord] breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. (cf. Song of Sol. 7:4,8.)

Ovary

See: Abdomen/Flesh/Reproductive System (this section).

Prostate (Thigh Muscle)

See: Legs/Groin (this section).

Reproductive System

(Children are a blessing and "heritage" of the Lord and are promised to all who desire them [Ps. 127:3-5; 128:1-6]. God is glorified and rejoices [John 15:7-11] when we bring forth good fruit of all kinds. Natural children as well as spiritual children are good fruit. Miscarriages and sterility are part of the curse of the Law [Deut. 28:18; Exod. 23:25,26]. Abimelech's wives, Sarah, Rebekah, Rachel, Hannah, and Elizabeth were all healed by God of barrenness! He is no respecter of persons [Acts 10:34]. He speaks of blessings of the breast and womb [Gen. 49:25]. And nothing is too hard for Him, even regenerating tissues or organs.)

Deuteronomy 7:9,12-15 ... there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle. And the Lord will take away from thee all sickness....

Deuteronomy 28:18,61; Gal. 3:13 (Christ has redeemed us from reproductive problems.)

(cf. Deut. 28:1-4; Ps. 113:9.)

See also: Hereditary Diseases (Part III).

Respiratory System

Genesis 2:7 And the Lord God... breathed into his nostrils the breath of life....

Acts 17:25 ... he giveth to all life, and breath....

Isaiah 42:5 [The Lord, our Creator, is] . . . he that giveth breath unto the people. . . .

Ezekiel 37:5 Thus saith the Lord God . . . I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live.

(cf. Ezek. 37:6,9,10.)

Lamentations 3:56 ... hide not thine ear at my breathing, at my cry.

Deuteronomy 28:22,61; Gal. 3:13 ("Consumption" is translated tuberculosis by New World Bible and Living Bible; infectious diseases by Good News Bible; and wasting disease by Basic English Bible. "Inflammation" is translated cold in the Septuagint Bible. "Extreme burning" is translated influenza by Byington.) Christ has redeemed us from every kind of lung disease and breathing disability.

Shoulder

Isaiah 10:27 ... his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing. (cf. Isa. 9:4; 14:24-26; Deut. 33:12; Ps. 81:6.)

Sinews (Muscles, Tendons, Ligaments, Connective Tissue)

Job 10:11 Thou hast clothed me with skin and flesh, and hast fenced me with bones and sinews.

Ezekiel 37:5,6 Thus saith the Lord God. . . . I will lay sinews upon you and will bring up flesh upon you. . . and ye shall live. . . .

Skin

Job 10:11,12 Thou hast clothed me with skin and flesh. . . .

Deuteronomy 28:27,35; Gal. 3:13 ("Botch of Egypt" is translated: ulcer by Young's Literal Bible; sores by Rotherham Bible; boils by NIV, NASB, RSV. "Scab" is translated: scurvy by Young's, Moffatt's, RSV; eczema by NASB; incurable itch by NASB; malignant scab by Septuagint; skin eruptions by New World Bible. "Sore botch" is translated: boil by Amplified Bible; a skin disease by Basic English Bible; a sore inflammation by Leeser's Bible.) Christ has redeemed us from every type of skin disease.

Additionally, verse 61 sums up by saying that every sickness and every plague which is not specifically named in this book of the Law is included in the curse, which rests upon those who are disobedient to God's Law.

But, thanks be to God! Galatians 3:13 says, "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law. . . ." That means healing has been provided for every sickness and disease known to man. Nothing is too hard for Jehovah Rapha (Exod. 15:26; Jer. 32:27)! Deuteronomy 23:5 says, ". . . the Lord thy God turned the curse into a blessing unto thee, because the Lord thy God loved thee"!

Christ has redeemed us from tumors, growths, abnormal lumps, cysts, and warts.

2 Corinthians 12:9,10 And he said unto me, My strength is made perfect in weakness... therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me... for when I am weak, then am I strong.

Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities... ("Supports us in our weakness" — Twentieth Century New Testament. Literally in the Greek: "sunanti-lambano-mai," or "the Spirit takes hold, together with us, against our infirmities and weaknesses.")

Romans 8:11 . . . the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead. . . shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. ("Quicken" literally: revitalize or make alive.)

Psalm 68:28,35 Thy God hath commanded thy strength: strengthen, O God, that which thou hast wrought for us. . . the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. . . .

Jeremiah 30:17 For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the Lord. . . .

Ezekiel 34:16 ... [The Lord] will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick....

Isaiah 53:5 . . . He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities. . . and with his stripes we are healed.

Matthew 15:30,31 ... having with them those that were... maimed... and he [Jesus] healed them... [and] they saw... the maimed to be whole....
