<u>Revelation 3:10</u> - Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

<u>2 Timothy 1:7</u> - For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Luke 21:34-36 - And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and [so] that day come upon you unawares. (Read More...)

Psalms 23:1 - (A Psalm of David.) The LORD [is] my shepherd; I shall not want.

<u>1 Peter 2:9</u> - But ye [are] a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

James 1:18 - Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

<u>Acts 20:35</u> - I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

Isaiah 44:1-28 - Yet now hear, O Jacob my servant; and Israel, whom I have chosen: (Read More...)

<u>Hebrews 4:16</u> - Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

<u>Philippians 4:6-7</u> - Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. (*Read More...*)

Galatians 5:22-23 - But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, (Read More...)

Luke 21:28 - And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

<u>Luke 12:15</u> - And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

<u>Matthew 28:1-20</u> - In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first [day] of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre. <u>(Read More...)</u>

Matthew 24:20-22 - But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: (Read More...)

Matthew 22:14 - For many are called, but few [are] chosen.

Micah 7:7 - Therefore I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me.

<u>1 Chronicles 28:20</u> - And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do [it]: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, [even] my God, [will be] with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

<u>Revelation 20:4</u> - And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and [I saw] the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received [his] mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

<u>Revelation 17:1-18</u> - And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters: <u>(Read More...)</u>

Revelation 5:10 - And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

Romans 8:7 - Because the carnal mind [is] enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

<u>John 8:44</u> - Ye are of [your] father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Matthew 24:9 - Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

<u>Matthew 7:13-14</u> - Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide [is] the gate, and broad [is] the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: (*Read More...*)

<u>Zephaniah 2:3</u> - Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

<u>Daniel 12:1</u> - And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation [even] to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

Isaiah 33:14 - The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?

Isaiah 3:10-11 - Say ye to the righteous, that [it shall be] well [with him]: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings. (*Read* <u>More...</u>)

Exodus 20:17 - Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] thy neighbour's.

Hebrews 12:29 - For our God [is] a consuming fire.

<u>Hebrews 11:35-40</u> - Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection: <u>(Read More...)</u>

2 Timothy 3:1-4 - This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. (Read More...)

<u>Philippians 4:3</u> - And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and [with] other my fellowlabourers, whose names [are] in the book of life.

<u>Galatians 5:1-26</u> - Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. <u>(Read More...)</u>

<u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u> - There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

<u>Matthew 10:17-18</u> - But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues; (*Read More...*)
