## Simplified Map

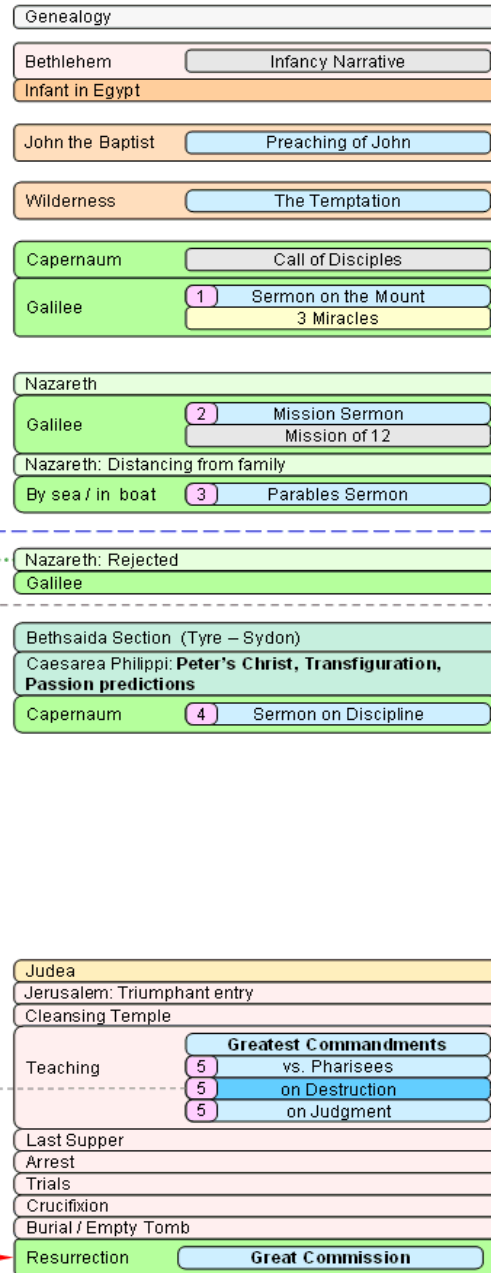
- North & East of Galilee

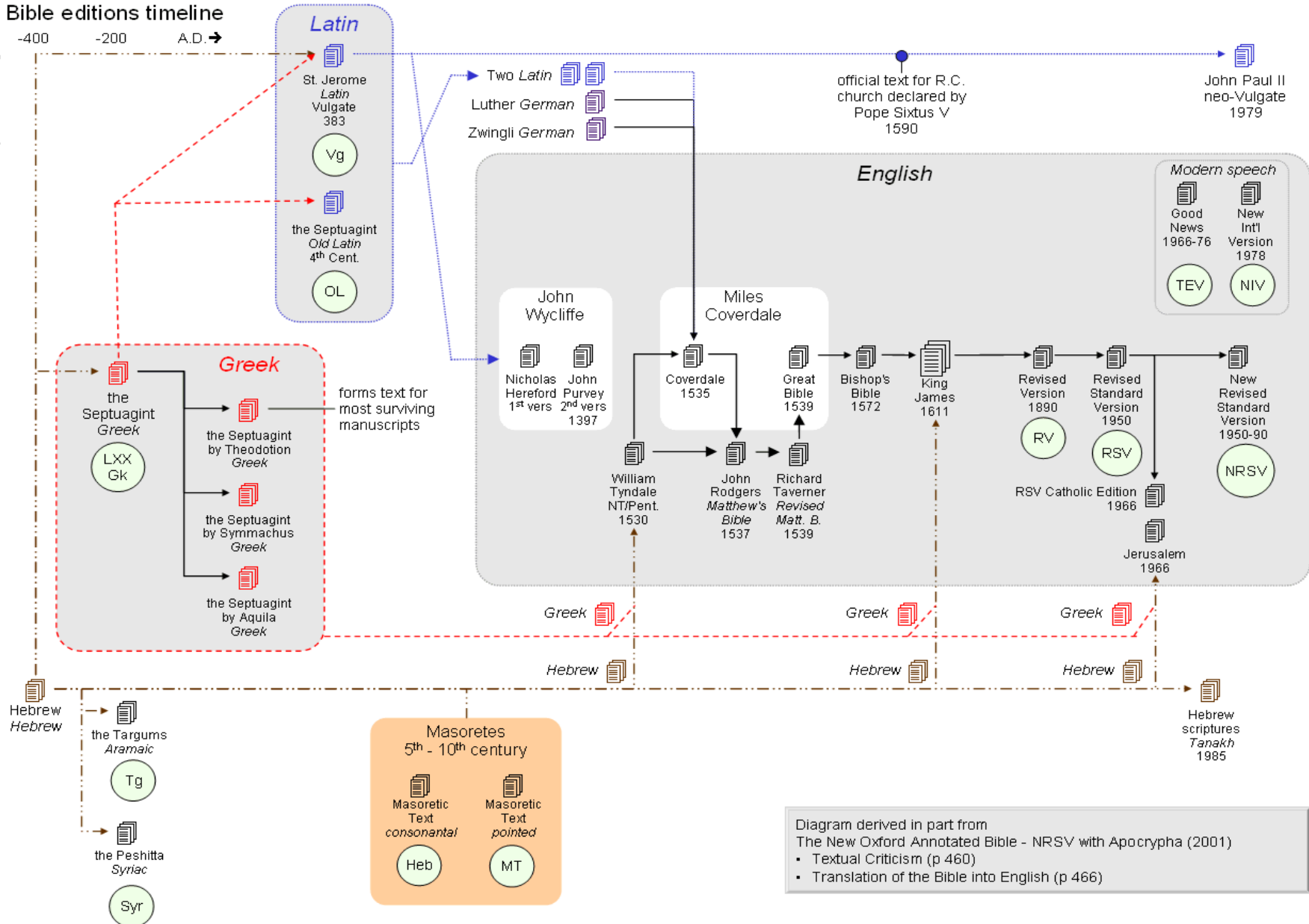
