
Being Born Again

John 3:3. KJV Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

John 3:5-7 NKJV Jesus answered, Truly, truly, I say to you, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said to you, You must be born again.-

John 3:16-18/Romans 5:6-11 For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that everyone who believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

Born Again from 1 Peter 1

- 1. Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the elect who are exiles of the Dispersion throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, chosen
- 2. according to the foreknowledge of God the Father and sanctified by the Spirit for obedience to Jesus Christ and sprinkling by His Blood: Grace and peace be yours in abundance.
- 3. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! By His great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- 4. and into an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, reserved in heaven for you,
- 5. who through faith are shielded by God's power for the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.
- 6. In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in various trials
- 7. so that the proven character of your faith—more precious than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire may result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- 8. Though you have not seen Him, you love Him; and though you do not see Him now, you believe in Him and rejoice with an inexpressible and glorious joy,
- 9. now that you are receiving the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls.
- 10. Concerning this salvation, the prophets who foretold the grace to come to you searched and investigated carefully,
- 11. trying to determine the time and setting to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when He predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow.
- 12. It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, when they foretold the things now announced by those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven. Even angels long to look into these things.
- 13. Therefore prepare your minds for action. Be sober-minded. Set your hope fully on the grace to be given you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

- 14. As obedient children, do not conform to the passions of your former ignorance.
- 15. But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do,
- 16. for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy." (Heb 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:)
- 17. Since you call on a Father who judges each one's work impartially, conduct yourselves in reverent fear during your stay as foreigners.
- 18. For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life you inherited from your forefathers,
- 19. but with the precious Blood of Christ, a Lamb without blemish or spot.
- 20. He was known before the foundation of the world, but was revealed in the last times for your sake.
- 21. Through Him you believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and glorified Him; and so your faith and hope are in God.
- 22. Since you have purified your souls by obedience to the truth so that you have a genuine love for your brothers, love one another deeply, from a pure heart.
- 23. For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.
- 24. For, "All flesh is like grass, and all its glory like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall,
- 25. but the Word of the Lord stands forever." (Isaiah 40.6-8) And this is the word that was proclaimed to you.

Justified by Faith in Romans 5

1. Therefore, since we have been justified/made righteous through faith, we have a peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

2. through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.

- 3. Not only that, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- 4. perseverance, character; and character, hope.

5. And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out His love into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, whom He has given us.

- 6. For at just the right time, while we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.
- 7. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die.
- 8. But God proves His love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

9. Therefore, since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more shall we be saved from wrath through Him!

10. For if, when we were enemies of God, we were reconciled to Him through the death of His Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through His life!

11. Not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

12. Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, so also death was passed on to all men, because all sinned.

13. For sin was in the world before the law was given; but sin is not taken into account when there is no law.

14. Nevertheless, death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who did not sin in the way that Adam transgressed. He is a pattern of the One to come.

15. But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many!

16. Again, the gift is not like the result of the one man's sin: The judgment that followed one sin brought condemnation, but the gift that followed many trespasses brought justification.

17. For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive an abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ!

18. So then, just as one trespass brought condemnation for all men, so also one act of righteousness brought

justification and life for all men.

19. For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.

20. The law came in so that the trespass would increase; but where sin increased, grace increased all the more, 21. so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Righteousness in Romans 10:4-12 (confession)

4. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

5. For Moses describeth the righteousness which is of the law, That the man which doeth those things shall live by them.

6. But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:)

7.Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.)

8. But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;

9. That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

10. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

11. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

12. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

13. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Righteousness in Romans (verses):

Romans 1:17 - For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "But the righteous man shall live by faith."

Romans 3:21 - But now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets,

Romans 3:22 - even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction;

Romans 3:26 - for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

Romans 4:5 - But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness,

Romans 4:13 - For the promise to Abraham or to his descendants that he would be heir of the world was not through the Law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Romans 5:17 - For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:19 - For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.

Romans 9:30 - What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, attained righteousness, even the righteousness which is by faith;

Romans 10:4 - For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Romans 10:6 - But the righteousness based on faith speaks as follows: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down),
