

The Christian Walk

- **Micah 6:8** He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

- **Amos 3:3** Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

- **Eph 4:1-3** I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

The Christian life is a forward progress/walk in our faith.

- **John 2** Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospers.

- **Mt 6:33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

- **Eph 4:17** This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

- **Eph 4:23&24** And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that you put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

We walk in Jesus:

- **John 10:3-5** To Him the porter opens; and the sheep hear His voice: and He calleth His own sheep by name and leads them out. And when He put forth His own sheep, He goes before them, and the sheep follow Him: for they know His voice. And a stranger will they not follow but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

- **John 8:12** Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the Light of the world: he that follows me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

- **John 12:35** Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the light with you. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knows not whither he goes.

- **1 John 1:6-7** But if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the Blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

We walk in love:

- **Ephesians 5:2** And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us, and has given Himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor.

- **2 John 1:5&6** (1 John 2:7&8) I write a new commandment (*John 13:34*) unto you, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. And this is love, that we walk after His commandments ...vs6 you should walk in it.

We walk by Faith: (Proverbs 3:5&6)

- **2Cor 5:7** For we walk by faith not by sight

- **1 Peter 2:21** For even hereunto were you called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:

- **Romans 6:4** Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

We walk in the Holy Spirit:

- **Romans 8:1** There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

- **Galatians 5:16&25** This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. **Contrast that to Jude 1:18** How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. **Micah 4:5** For all people will walk every one in the name of his god, and we will walk in the name of the LORD our God for ever and ever.

PRAYER: Colossians 1:10 That you might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Ephesians Chapter 4

- 1** I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called,
- 2** With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;
- 3** Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- 4** There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you are called in one hope of your calling;
- 5** One Lord, one faith, one baptism,
- 6** One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.
- 7** But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.
- 8** Wherefore He said, When He ascended up on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.
- 9** (Now that He ascended, what is it but that He also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?)
- 10** He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that He might fill all things.)
- 11** And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;
- 12** For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:
- 13** Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:
- 14** That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;
- 15** But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into Him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:
- 16** From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplies, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, makes increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.
- 17** This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,
- 18** Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:
- 19** Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.
- 20** But ye have not so learned Christ;
- 21** If so be that ye have heard Him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:
- 22** That you put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
- 23** And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
- 24** And that you put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
- 25** Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.
- 26** Be you angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:
- 27** Neither give place to the devil.
- 28** Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needs.
- 29** Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.
- 30** And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby you are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 31** Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:
- 32** And be you kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you.
