Mark 6:23, Esther 5:3 both say: Whatever you ask I will give you, up to half my kingdom.

..but there is a very different response in each case.

Esther knew that the key for her was in her ongoing relationship with the King.

God has a unique word for each person that will be different to the word for their neighbour. We all hear things differently according to our hearts as in the parable of the sower.

John 6 I am the Bread of Life

John 6:27-29

Labour not for the meat which perisheth but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed

John 6:33-35

For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world

Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst

John 6:40-41

And this is the will of him that sent me; that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life, and I will raise him up at the last day. The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.

And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How is it then that he saith, I came down from heaven?
