

Righteousness in Jesus

James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that you may be healed. **The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man/woman avails much.**

Romans 5:1 (YLT) Having *been declared righteous*, then, by faith, we have peace toward God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

Romans 3:22 Even the *righteousness of God* which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all *them that believe*: for there is no difference:

1 Corinthians 1:30 But of Him are you in Christ Jesus, who of God is *made unto us* wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He (Father God) hath made Him (Jesus) to be a sin (offering) for us, who knew no sin; that *we might be made the righteousness* of God in Him.

1 Peter 2:24 Who His own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, *should live unto righteousness*: by whose stripes you were healed.

Righteousness must be pursued.

Proverbs 21:21 He that follows after righteousness and mercy finds life, righteousness, and honour.

1 Timothy 6:11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.

Matthew 5:6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

Matthew 5:10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Righteousness is our inheritance.

Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.

Ephesians 4:23&24 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

Galatians 3:8&9 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, "In thee shall all nations be blessed". So, then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

Righteousness is by FAITH - Habakkuk 2:4 & Hebrews 10:38

Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, the just shall live by faith. **Vs 16:** For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believes; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

Galatians 5:5&6 For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision avails anything, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

2 Cor 6:7 By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left...

Ephesians 6:10-18 / Isaiah 59:16-17, 19-standard

10. Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.

11. Put on the whole armour of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

12. For we *wrestle not against flesh and blood*, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

13. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, **and having done all, to stand.**

14. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the *breastplate of righteousness*;

15. And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

16. Above all, taking the *shield of faith*, wherewith you shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

17. And take the *helmet of salvation*, and *the sword of the Spirit*, which is the **Word of God**:

18. **Praying always** with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for **all** saints;

19. **And for me/you:** that utterance may be given unto me/you, that I/we may open my/your mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,
