- **Micah 5:2 / Luke 2:4&7, 12** Jesus was born in Bethlehem, And this shall be a sign unto you; You shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.
- **Zech 9:9 / Matt 21:2 / Mark 11:3 / Luke 19:30** Colt tied up. **Zech 11:12-13 / Matt 26:14-15** Thirty pieces of silver.

GOD IS IN THE DETAILS, NOT THE DEVIL!

- **Swaddling clothes** described in the Bible consisted of a cloth tied together by bandage-like strips. When the declaration was made to these **Levitical** Shepherds that watched their sheep in a special field full of sacrificial lambs, *they apparently knew exactly where to go to discover that Baby*. GOD IS IN CONTROL:

- **Proverbs 8:14-17** Counsel is Mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength. By Me kings reign, and princes decree justice. By Me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth. I love them that love Me; and those that seek Me early shall find Me.
 - **Matt 6:34** Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.
 - **Matt 11:28-30** Come unto Me, all you that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and you shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
 - **John 10:27-30** My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, *neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand*. My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and *no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand*. I and my Father are one.
 - **John 14:1** Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me.
 - **John 19:25** Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene. When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple standing by, whom He loved, He saith unto His mother, “*Woman, behold thy son!*” Then saith He to the disciple (John), “*Behold thy mother!*” And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home.
 - **1 John 5:4** For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
- ## GOD'S TIMING:
- **Ecclesiastes 3:11** He has made every thing beautiful in His time: also He hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end.
 - **Philippians 1:6** Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:
 - **1 Peter 5:6&7** Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon Him; for He cares for you.
 - **1 Peter 5:10** But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that you have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.
 - **Luke 21:24b** ...until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.

GOD IS ONE OF ORDER:

- **Psalm 22:18 / John 19:23** - Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. They said therefore among themselves, "Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be:" **that the scripture might be fulfilled**, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.

- **John 19:28** After this, Jesus *knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled*, saith, "I thirst".

- **John 19:30** When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, "**It is finished**" (*tetelestai* - paid in full): and He bowed His head and gave up the ghost.

- **John 20:7** And the napkin, that was about His head, not lying with the linen clothes, but **wrapped** together in a place by itself.

- **Romans 12:3b** ...according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

GOD the FATHER, JESUS the SON, and the HOLY GHOST/SPIRIT ARE ONE: (1 John 5:7 below)

Genesis 1: In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the **Word was God**. The same was in the beginning with God. **All things were made by Him**; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. In Him was life; and the life was the light of men. And the Light shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

John 1:14 **The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us.** We have seen His glory, the glory of the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:29 The next day John sees Jesus coming unto him, and said, "*Behold the Lamb of God, which takes away the sin of the world*". **Vs34** And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.

John 10:30 I and my Father are one.

John 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known Me, Philip? he that hath seen Me hath seen the Father; and how say thou then, Show us the Father?

1 John 5:7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these Three are one.

- **Psalm 31:5 / Luke 23:45b** Into Thine hand I commit my spirit: Thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.

1Peter1:18-21 Forasmuch as you know that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; **but with the precious Blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot**: Who verily was **foreordained before the foundation of the world**, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by Him do believe in God, that raised Him up from the dead, and gave Him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

- **Exodus 12:5 / Leviticus 22:20 / 1 Peter 1:19** the Levitical Lamb was to be without blemish or spot.
