A journey through the Bible about/with the Holy Spirit

Genesis 1:2 The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

Numbers 11:17 And I will come down and talk with you there. And I will take some of the Spirit that is **on you** and put it on them, and they shall bear the burden of the people with you, so that you may not bear it yourself alone.

Ezekiel 11:19, 36:26–27 And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put **within you**. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit **within you** and cause you to walk in My statutes and be careful to obey My rules.

Joel 2:28-32 "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will **pour out** My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out My Spirit.

Isaiah 11:1–10 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit. And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest *upon him*, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

Isaiah 28:10-12 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little." *For with stammering lips and another tongue*. He will speak to this people, to whom He said, "This is the rest with which You may cause the weary to rest," and, "This is the refreshing"; Yet they would not hear.

Isaiah 32:15 Until the Spirit is **poured upon** us from on high, and the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field is deemed a forest.

Isaiah 61:1-4 The Spirit of the Lord God is **upon me**; because the Lord **hath anointed me** to preach good tidings unto the meek; He **hath sent me** to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; **To proclaim** the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; **To appoint** unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He might be glorified. (**Luke 4:1, 18&19**) And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost...

Matthew 12:28 But if it is by the Spirit of God that I cast out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Matthew 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, (**Acts 2:38/19:6**) And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.)

Luke 3:15–17 As the people were in expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether He might be the Christ, John answered them all, saying, "I baptize you with water, but He who is mightier than I is coming, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in His hand, to clear His threshing floor and to gather the wheat into His barn, but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire." (**Mark 8:1**)

Luke 24:49 And behold, I am **sending the promise** of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you ware clothed with power from on high."

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, **except a man be born** of water and **of the Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. (**John 3:3** – You must be born again.)

John 14:16-17 And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, neither knows Him: but you know Him; for He dwelleth with you and shall be in you. I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. John 14:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceeded from the Father, He shall testify of Me: John 15:26 But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, He will bear witness about Me.

John 16:13–15 Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak and He will shew you things to come. He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of mine and shall shew it unto you. All things that the Father hath are Mine: therefore said I, that He shall take of Mine, and shall show it unto you. (Col 2:9 For in Him/Jesus dwells all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.)

Acts 1:4–8 And while staying with them He ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, He said, "you heard from Me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." (Luke 24:49)

Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Romans 8:13–17 For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

Romans 8:26–27 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the **Spirit Himself intercedes** for us with groanings too deep for words. And He who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the **Spirit intercedes for the saints** according to the will of God.

1Cor3:16 Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?

1Cor6:19-20 Or do you not know that **your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit** within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

1Cor14:1+ Pursue love, and **earnestly desire the spiritual gifts**, especially that you may prophesy. For one who speaks in a tongue speaks not to men but to God; for no one understands him, but he utters mysteries in the Spirit.

- **2 Corinthians 3:3-8** And you show that you are a letter from Christ delivered by us, **written not with ink** but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts.
- **2 Corinthians 3:17-18** Now the **Lord is the Spirit**, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

Galatians 5:16/18/22 But I say, **walk by the Spirit**, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness...

Ephesians 1:13 In Him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in Him, were **sealed with the promised** Holy Spirit,

Ephesians 4:30 And **do not grieve** the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. (Isaiah 63:10) But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, and he fought against them. **1 Thessalonians 5:19 Do not quench** the Spirit. **Titus 3:5** He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to His own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit,

- **1 John 5:5-8** Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that bears witness, because the Spirit is truth. **For there are three that bear record in heaven**, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: *and these three are one*. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.
- Rev 1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,
- **Rev 2:7** He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- Rev 3:22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- **Rev 4:5** and out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thundering's and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.
- **Rev 5:6** And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
- **Rev 14:13** And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.
- **Rev 22:17** And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

How do you know you have the gift of the Holy Spirit?

Acts 10:44-46 While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. And the believers from among the circumcised who had come with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out even on the Gentiles. For they were hearing them speaking in tongues and extolling God.

Acts 19:1-6 And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, He said unto them, "Have you received the Holy Ghost since you believed?" And they said unto him, "We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost." And he said unto them, "Unto what then were you baptized?" And they said, "Unto John's baptism." Then said Paul, "John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on Him which should come after Him, that is, on Christ Jesus." When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

My Prayer for you:

Jude1:17-25 But, beloved, remember you the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ; how that they told you there *should be mockers in the last time*, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit. *But you, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost*, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference: and others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. *Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling*, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, to the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever.

1 Corinthians 12

- 1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant.
- 2 You know that you were Gentiles, carried away unto these dumb idols, even as you were led.
- 3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.
- 4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- **5** And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.
- 6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.
- 7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.
- 8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;
- 9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
- 10 **To another** the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:
- 11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.
- 12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

- 14 For the body is not one member, but many.
- 15 If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
- 16 And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
- 17 If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?
- 18 But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.
- 19 And if they were all one member, where were the body?
- 20 But now are they many members, yet but one body.
- 21 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

22 Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

- 23 And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.
- 24 For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked.
- 25 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.
- 26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

27 Now you are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

- 28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, **after that** miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.
- 29 Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles?
- 30 Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?
- 31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- **1 Cor 13:1 Though I speak with the tongues** of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.
- **1Cor 14:1** Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that you may prophesy.
- 2 For he that speaks in an unknown tongue speaks not unto men, but unto God: for no man understands him; howbeit in the spirit he speaks mysteries.
- 3 But he that prophesies speaks unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort.

4 He that speaks in an unknown tongue edifies himself; but he that prophesies edifies the church.

- 5 I would **that you all spoke with tongues** but **rather that you prophesied**: for greater is he that prophesies than he that speaks with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.
- 6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?
- 7 And even things without life giving sound, whether pipe or harp, except they give a distinction in the sounds, how shall it be known what is piped or harped?
- 8 For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?
- 9 So likewise you, except you utter by the tongue words easy to be understood, how shall it be known what is spoken? for you shall speak into the air.
