1 Thess 5:5-28

5 Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.

6 Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.

7 For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.

8 But let us</mark>, who are of the day, <mark>be sober</mark>, putting on the breastplate of faith and love</mark>; and for an <mark>helmet, the hope of salvation</mark>.

9 Fo<mark>r God hath not appointed us</mark> to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
