

Sanctified by the Body & Blood of Jesus - Hebrews 10.

Hebrews 10:

1. For the law (Leviticus 1:1-17) having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

2. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.

3. But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.

4. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

5. Wherefore when He came into the world, He said, "Sacrifice and offering thou would not, but a body hast Thou prepared Me:

6. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had had no pleasure.

- Jeremiah 7:21-23 nor commanded them

- Hosea 6:6 For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

- Psalm 40:6-8 Sacrifice and offering thou didst not desire; I delight to do Thy will, O my God:

- Psalm 51:16&17 For You desire not sacrifice. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart

- Isaiah 1:11 I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of...

7. Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of Me,) to do Thy will, Oh God."

8. Above when He said, "Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin Thou would not, neither hast pleasure therein; which are offered by the law;"

9. Then said He, "Lo, I come to do Thy will, Oh God". He takes away the first, that He may establish the second.

10. By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ ONCE for all.

11. And every priest stands daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

12. But this Man, after He had offered ONE sacrifice for sins forever, sat down on the right hand of God;

13. From henceforth expecting till His enemies be made His footstool.

14. For by ONE offering He hath perfected forever them that are sanctified.

15. Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that He had said before, (1 John 5:6 Spirit testifies)

16. "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days", saith the Lord, "I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

17. And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more." (Psalm 51:9-12 Create in me a clean heart...)

18. Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.

19. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the Blood of Jesus,

20. By a new and living way, which He hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh;

22. Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

23. Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for He is faithful that promised;

Sanctified

To set apart as or declare holy; consecrate: "a small shrine was built to sanctify the site"

To make legitimate or binding by religious sanction: "they see their love sanctified by the sacrament of marriage"

To be free from sin; purify: "may God sanctify his soul"

To cause to be or seem morally right or acceptable: "ancient customs that are sanctified by tradition"

Hebrews 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all

Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

Hebrews 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose you, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

John 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be **sanctified** through the Truth.

Acts 20:32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are **sanctified**.

Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are **sanctified** by faith that is in me.

Romans 15:16 That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being **sanctified** by the Holy Ghost.

1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you: but you are washed, but you are **sanctified**, but you are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

Justification means our declared righteousness before God, made possible by Christ's death and resurrection for us. **Sanctification** means our gradual, growing righteousness, made possible by the Spirit's work in us.
