

Standing on the Promises of God

1. God promises us that nothing can separate us from His Love – (NKJV) **Romans 8:35** **Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?** Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? (the answer is NO) (NKJV) **Romans 8:31-32** What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
2. God promises to work everything together for good – (NKJV) **Romans 8:28** **And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God,** to those who are the called according to His purpose.
3. God promises that He has made you a new creation. (NKJV) **2 Cor 5:17** **Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation;** old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
4. God promises you that He will protect you. (NKJV) **Psalm 91:3** **Surely, He shall deliver you** from the snare of the [a]fowler and from the perilous pestilence.
5. God promises to heal you. (NKJV) **1 Peter 2:24** **who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree,** that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose [a]stripes you were healed.**

6. God promises to give you peace (NKJV) **Isaiah 26:3** **You will keep him in perfect peace**, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.
7. God promises to be near (NKJV) **James 4:8** **Draw near to God** and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.
8. God promises to prosper you and not harm you. (NKJV) **Jeremiah 29:11** For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
9. God promises to not condemn you. (NKJV) **Romans 8:1** There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who[a] do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. **I'm not who the enemy says I am**
10. God promises to bless you. (NKJV) **Deut 28: 2-6** And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God: "Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country.
11. God promises He will give us victory through Christ. (NKJV) **Romans 8:37** Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
12. God promises to comfort us. (NKJV) **2Cor 1: 4-5** **Blessed be the God** and Father of our Lord Jesus

Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,
4 who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may
be able to comfort those who are in any [a]trouble,
with the (same)comfort with which we ourselves are
comforted by God. 5 For as the sufferings of Christ
abound in us, so our [b]consolation also abounds
through Christ.

There's a whole bunch of promises in Deuteronomy 28. The promises are based on obedience to the law of God. As New Covenant believers, the promises of Deuteronomy 28 are available to you and me because of Jesus' obedience to the law. Because He fulfilled the law completely, I have access to every promise of Deuteronomy 28 and am free of every curse. Your children are blessed, your career is blessed, your household are blessed, and wherever you go is blessed. ONLY BELIEVE! Then STAND! The Blessings of Abraham were given to Abraham and his SEED and JESUS is the SEED of Abraham! NKJV Gal 3:16 Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ. NKJV Gal3:27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. NKJV Gal3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. NKJV Gal 3:29 **And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

(NKJV) Romans 2:28-29 For he is not a Jew who *is* one outwardly, nor *is* circumcision that which *is* outward in the flesh; but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God.

My summation from the Word is that all the promises are yes and amen to all those who are in Christ Jesus who was a Jew in the flesh!
