It all by God's grace! Pick up how many times the verses say "by", "of", or "in" Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:8-10. "For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. **For we are His workmanship**, created **in Christ Jesus** unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."

Ephesians 4:7 But unto **every one of us is given grace** according to the measure of the **gift of Christ**.

1. Sanctification: To make holy, set apart.

ἁγιασμός (hagiasmos) *Sanctification, holiness, consecration* (gadosh/qodesh) (Strong's 6918/6944)
- the process of making or becoming holy, set apart, sanctification, holiness, consecration.

OT Exodus 29:42-45 This shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: where I will meet you, to speak there unto thee. And there I will meet with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be **sanctified by My glory**. And I will **sanctify the tabernacle** of the congregation, and the altar: I will sanctify also.

NT 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 For **you are the temple of the living God**; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people...and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

John 17:14-19. I have given them Thy Word; and the world has hated them, because **they are not of the world**, even as I am not of the world. I pray not that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. **Sanctify them through Thy Truth: Thy Word is Truth.** (James 1:8, Eph 5:26-27 That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the **washing of water by the word**, John 15:3 Now you are clean through the Word.)

Romans 6:19&22 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as you have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now **yield your members servants** to righteousness unto holiness. **vs22.** But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, you have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

1 Corinthians 1:25-31 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. **For you see your calling**, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: but **God has chosen** the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God has chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; and base things of the world, and things which are despised, **hath God chosen**, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: that no flesh should glory in His presence. But of Him are you **in Christ Jesus**, who of God is made unto us **wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption**: that, according as it is written, He that glories, let him **glory in the Lord**.

Hebrews 10:10-24 sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ: By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the **body of Jesus Christ** once for all.

Hebrews 13:12 sanctified through the **Blood of Jesus Christ**: "Wherefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own Blood, suffered without the gate..."

2. Justification: To make righteous.

δικαίωσις (dikaiós) Justification acquittal, justifying, justification, a process of absolution.

Counted righteous by faith through Jesus Christ (Strong's 1344/1347)

Romans 3:23-25 ...Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: for all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; to declare, I say, at this time His righteousness: that He might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

Romans 5:1-5 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Ephesians 4:11-16 And He (Jesus) gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into Him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplies, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

Titus 3:5-7 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, *Not by works of righteousness* which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; that being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that you affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God *might be careful to maintain good works*. These things are good and profitable unto men.

Galatians 2:16-19 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

[“of” Jesus rather than “in” ...*the verb πιστεύω rather than the noun implies that the object of faith is a worthy object, for He Himself is faithful.*]

Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover, whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.

2 Cor 5:17-21 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. **vs20** Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, **vs21b** that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.

3. Crucifixion: To extinguish (subdue) passion and selflessness.

συνεσταύρωμαι/συνεσταυρώθη (synestaurōmai/synestaurōthē) *crucified with* (Strong's 4957)

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me.

Romans 6:3-14 Know you not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into His death? Therefore, we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection: **vs6** Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him: knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dies no more; death hath no more dominion over Him. For in that He died, He died unto sin once: but in that He lives, He lives unto God. **vs11** Likewise reckon you also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. (**Romans 12:2** that you present your bodies a living sacrifice)

2 Corinthians 12:9-10 And He said unto me, "My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness". Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore, I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

Colossians 2:20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are you subject to ordinances,

2 Timothy 2:10-13 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with Him, we shall also live with Him: if we suffer, we shall also reign with Him: if we deny Him, He also will deny us: if we believe not, yet He abides faithful: He cannot deny himself.

Colossians 3:1-5 If you then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sits on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For you are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall you also appear with Him in glory. Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:

Ephesians 2:1-2 And you has He quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins; wherein in time past you walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now works in the children of disobedience: But God, who is rich in mercy, for His great love wherewith He loved us, even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come He might shew the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. (and vs 8-10 at beginning.)

Matthew 10:38 And he (you) that takes not his cross, and follows after Me, is not worthy of Me. He that finds his life shall lose it: and he that loses his life for My sake shall find it.

4. Glorification: To describe/represent something as admirable, especially unjustifiably. ἐνδοξάζω (endoxazomai) *To be glorified, to be held in honor. (Strong's 1740).*

Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also **did predestinate** to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He *did predestinate*, them He *also called*: and whom He called, them **He also justified**: and whom He justified, them **He also glorified**.

1 Thessalonians 1:10-12 When He shall come **to be glorified in his saints**, and to be admired *in all them that believe* (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day. Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power: that the **name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you**, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 1:24-27 ...according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the Word of God; even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to His saints: to whom God would make known what is the **riches of the glory** of this mystery among *the Gentiles*; **which is Christ in you, the hope of glory**: whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man **perfect in Christ Jesus**: whereunto I also labour, striving **according to His working**, which works in me mightily.

Romans 8:18-19 For I **reckon** that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with **the glory** which shall be revealed in us. For the earnest expectation of the creature **waits** for the **manifestation of the sons of God**.

5. Redemification: To redeem, act as kinsman-redeemer, avenge, ransom, deliver. גאל gaal: It involves the idea of buying back or reclaiming something or someone, often in the context of familial duty. *This term is used to describe the act of a close relative who restores the rights of another and avenges their wrongs. (Strong's 1350).*

Exodus 6:6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and **I will rid** you out of their bondage, and **I will redeem you** with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:

1 Peter 1:15-19 But as He which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, **Be ye holy; for I am holy**. And if you call on the Father, who **without respect of persons** judges according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear: Forasmuch as you know that you **were not redeemed with corruptible things**, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; **but with the precious Blood of Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Colossians 1:14 In whom we have **redemption through His Blood**, even the forgiveness of sins:

Hebrews 9:12-16 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His own Blood He entered in **once** into the holy place, having **obtained eternal redemption** for us. For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the Blood of Christ, who **through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God**, **purge your conscience from dead works** to serve the living God?

Revelation 14:3 And they sung as it were **a new song** before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the *hundred and forty and four thousand*, which were **redeemed from the earth**.

Finally:

Romans 12:1-6a I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be you transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Hebrews 12:1-2 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which does so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He (Jesus) shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.
