

Glorifying God

Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

John 15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit; so shall you be my disciples.

Romans 8:18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the *glory which shall be revealed* in us.

1 Cor 6:15-20 Know you not that your bodies are the members of Christ? But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. What? know you not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which you have of God, and you are not your own? For you are bought with a price: therefore, *glorify God in your body, and in your spirit*, which are God's.

1 Cor 10:31 Whether therefore you eat, or drink, or whatsoever you do, do all to the glory of God.

1 Peter 2:12 Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by *your* good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

1 Peter 4:11 If any man speak, *let him speak* as the oracles of God; if any man minister, *let him do it* as of the ability which God gives: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

1 Peter 4:16 Yet if *any man suffer* as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.

Psalms 50:23 Whoso offers praise glorifies Me: and to him that ordered *his* conversation *aright* will I shew the salvation of God.

Psalms 57:5 Be you exalted, O God, above the heavens; *let* Thy glory *be* above all the earth.

2 Cor 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord.

2 Cor 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, has shined in our hearts, to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 7:12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, *be* unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 21:23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God does light it, and the Lamb *is* the light thereof.

Healing Glorifies God...

Matthew 15:31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

Luke 5:25/Mark 2:12 *Man lowered on a cot.* And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

Luke 7:14-16 *a son raised from the dead.* And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

Luke 17:15-19 *the 10 lepers.* And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell facedown at Jesus' feet in thanksgiving to Him—and he was a Samaritan. “Were not all ten cleansed?” Jesus asked. “Where then are the other nine? Was no one found except this foreigner to return and give glory to God?” Then Jesus said to him, “Rise and go; your faith has made you whole!”

Luke 23:47 *at the cross.* Now when the centurion saw what was done, he glorified God, saying, “Certainly this was a righteous man”.

John 11:4 *Lazarus' death.* When Jesus heard *that*, He said, “This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby”.

Fearing God glorifies Him...

Acts 12:23 Immediately, because Herod did not give glory to God, an angel of the Lord struck him.

Jeremiah 13:15-16 Hear you and give ear; be not proud: for the LORD hath spoken. Give glory to the LORD your God, before He cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while you look for light, He turn it into the shadow of death, *and make it gross darkness.*

Psalms 79:9 Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Thy name: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for Thy name's sake.

Philippians 2:11 And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Revelation 11:13 the two witness get killed, a big earthquake, the remnant were affrighted and gave glory to the God of heaven.

Revelation 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, “Fear God, and give glory to Him; for the hour of His judgment is come: and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters”.

Interesting...

Prov 25:2 *It is* the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings *is* to search out a matter.

Prov 18:23b before honour is humility
