Habakkuk means embrace or cling to God

- Death throes of Judah (northern Israel was already captured by the Assyrians)
- Repentance, a call to
- Babylon is coming!

Pride - looks inside to self, whereas Faith looks outside to the Lord.

Pride - insatiable, no lasting rest, no integrity.

Habakkuk 2

1. I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what He will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.

2. And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that reads it.

3. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

4. Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

- **Romans 1:17** For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

- **Galatians 3:11** But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

- **Hebrews 10:38** Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

14. For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.

- **Daniel 12:4** But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

- **2 Corinthians 4:6** For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Habakkuk 3

17. Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls:

18. Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation.

19. The Lord God is my strength, and He will make my feet like hinds' feet, and He will make me to walk upon mine high places. *To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.*
