

In the Name of Jesus

Acts 4:12 Nor is there salvation in any other, for **there is no other name** under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Philippians 2:9-11 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, **that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow**, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and *that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord*, to the glory of God the Father.

Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: **in My name** they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

Luke 10:17 Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to *us in Your name.*"

John 3:18 "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not *believed in the name* of the only begotten Son of God

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "***I am the way, the truth, and the life.*** No one comes to the Father except through Me.

John 14:13&14 And whatever you ask **in My name**, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

John 16:26 In that day you will ask **in My name**, and I do not say to you that I shall pray the Father for you; (*read verses 25-28 to get context of us speaking to the Father directly*).

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you *be baptized in the name* of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 3:6 Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: *In the name* of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."

Acts 3:16 And His name, through faith *in His name*, has made this man strong, whom you see and know. Yes, the faith which *is by Him* has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

Revelation 22:13 "I am the *Alpha and the Omega*, *the Beginning and the End*, the First and the Last."

Exodus 3:14 And God said to Moses, “**I AM WHO I AM.**” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”

“**Jesus Christ of Nazareth.**” It is perfectly acceptable and respectful to refer to Jesus that way.

This phrase combines His name (Jesus), His title (Christ/Messiah), and His place of origin (Nazareth). It is a historically accurate and biblically sound description often used to identify Him. - Acts 3:6

“*Jesus*” means “**Yahweh saves**” (or “salvation”), and “*Christ*” signifies He is the anointed messiah, and “of Nazareth” highlights His humble origin.

Jesus’ actual name would have been *Yeshua ben Youssef*, which translates to “*Joshua, son of Joseph,*” in English. We use an Anglicized Greek form of Yeshua, “*Iesous*” (Yay-soos), because there is another Biblical figure whose name was also Joshua - the first Judge of Israel, who led the people into the land of Canaan following the 40 years of wandering that came after the Exodus.

Yehoshua (Hebrew) -> *Yeshua* (Aramaic/Hebrew) -> *Iesous* (Greek) -> *Jesus* (Latin) -> *Jesus* (English).

There are people who use “**Yeshua**” as Jesus’ name, just as there are people who prefer the Hebrew “**Yahweh**” over the more common English “**Jehovah**” for the name of God the Father. - John Cate

“**Yahshua**” is where we get the modern name “Joshua” from. It is personal and individual, and He knows who you’re trying to pray to. He knows exactly who you mean and want when you pray.

Why do people say Jesus Christ when Christ, the Messiah, is a title, and not a last name?

Should it not be Christ Jesus or Jesus the Christ?

I think it is a linguistic feature. Not every language uses an article such as “*the*.” Some languages, such as Greek, which have an article don’t always use it.

From the earliest days of the Jesus movement, people were referring to Jesus as Ιησούς Χριστός (Jesus Christ) and not as Ιησούς ο Χριστός (Jesus *the* Christ). This usage was translated directly into some Romance languages.

In Spanish, Jesus’ name and title are rendered as a single name: “**Jesucristo**”. In French, the name is hyphenated: **Jésus-Christ**. In English, the name and title are kept separate: *Jesus Christ*. However, in Hebrew and Arabic, people include the article “the”: “*Yeshua HaMashiach*” and “*Isa Al-Masih*”.

So, there is no single right or wrong way to use Jesus’ name and title.

Most people will understand you if you use any of these forms. **Jesus understands you** when you address Him directly, *and that’s the most important of all.* - David Wittenberg

The 105+ Names of Jesus:

MAN OF SORROWS

(Isaiah 53:3) He is despised and rejected of men; a man of *sorrows*, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.

MEDIATOR

(1 Timothy 2:5) For there is one God, and one *mediator* between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

ROSE OF SHARON

(Song of Songs 2:1) I am the *rose* of Sharon, and the lily of the valleys.

SAVIOR

(Luke 2:11) For unto you is born this day in the city of David a *Saviour*, which is Christ the Lord.

SHEPHERD AND BISHOP OF SOUL

(1 Peter 2:25) For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the *Shepherd* and Bishop of your souls.

SHILOH

(Genesis 49:10) The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between His feet, until *Shiloh* come; and unto Him shall the gathering of the people be.

SON OF THE BLESSED

(Mark 14:61) But He held His peace and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked Him, and said unto him, "Art thou the Christ, the Son of the *Blessed*?"

SON OF DAVID

(Matthew 1:1) The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of *David*, the son of Abraham.

THE SON OF GOD

(Matthew 2:15) And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called *My* son.

SON OF MAN

(Luke 19:10) For the Son of *Man* came to seek and to save the lost.

SON OF THE HIGHEST

(Luke 1:32) He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the *Highest*: and the Lord God shall give unto Him the throne of His father David:

SUN OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

(Malachi 4:2) But unto you that fear My name shall the *Sun* of righteousness arise with healing in His wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

TRUE LIGHT

(John 1:9) That was the *true* Light, which lights every man that comes into the world.

TRUE VINE

(John 15:1) I am the *true* vine, and My Father is the husbandman.

TRUTH

(John 1:14) And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and *truth*.

WITNESS

(Isaiah 55:4) Behold, I have given Him for a *witness* to the people, a leader and commander to the people.

WORD

(John 1:1) In the beginning was the *Word*, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

WORD OF GOD

(Revelation 19:13) And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His name is called The *Word* of God.

VICTORIOUS ONE

(Revelations 3:21) To the one who is *victorious*, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on His throne.

WONDERFUL COUNSELOR, MIGHTY GOD, EVERLASTING FATHER, PRINCE OF PEACE

(Isaiah 9:6) For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called *Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace*.
