HOLY MONDAY	Jesus cleanses the Temple of merchants and money changers.	Demonstrates Jesus' desire to purify the temple of the Lord.

MAUNDY THURSDAY - THE LAST SUPPER	Jesus washes disciples' feet and shares the Last Supper.	Institutes the <mark>Eucharist</mark> and models servitude.	Matthew 26:17-30; <mark>Mark 14:12-</mark> <mark>26</mark> ; Luke 22:7-38; John 13:1-30
MAUNDY THURSDAY TO GOOD FRIDAY - THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN AND ARREST	Jesus prays in <mark>Gethsemane</mark> and is arrested.	Shows Jesus' submission to God's will.	Matthew 26:36-56; Mark 14:32- 52; Luke 22:39-53; <mark>John 18:1-12</mark>
<mark>GOOD FRIDAY - PETER'S</mark> DENIAL	Peter denies knowing Jesus three times.	Illustrates fear, failure, and the possibility of forgiveness.	<u>Matthew 26:69-75</u> ; Mark 14:66- 72; Luke 22:54-62; John 18:15- 27
<mark>GOOD FRIDAY - JESUS'</mark> TRIALS	Jesus faces trials before Jewish and Roman leaders	Culminates in the sentence of crucifixion.	Matthew 26:57-27:26, Mark 14:53-15:15, Luke 22-66-23:25, <mark>John 18:13-:36</mark>
GOOD FRIDAY - CRUCIFIXION AND DEATH	Jesus is crucified and dies on the cross	Atones for humanity's sins and completes His sacrificial role	<u>Matthew 27:31-56</u> ; Mark 15:20-41; Luke 23:26-49; John 19:16-37
<mark>GOOD FRIDAY - JESUS'</mark> BURIAL	Jesus is buried in Joseph of <mark>Arimathea</mark> 's tomb.	Marks Jesus' human death and sets the stage for the Resurrection.	Matthew 27:57-61; Mark 15:42-47; Luke 23:50-56; <u>John</u> <u>19:38-42</u>
HOLY SATURDAY	Jesus' body rests in the tomb.	A day of mourning and reflection.	<u>Matthew 27:62-66</u> ; Luke 23:56
EASTER SUNDAY - THE RESURRECTION	Jesus is resurrected and appears to Mary Magdalene and the disciples	Confirms Jesus' victory over death and His divinity.	Matthew 28:1-20; Mark 16:1- 20; Luke 24:1-53; John20:1- 21:25
