

## Psalm 91 – a Personalized confession...

**1. I dwell in the secret place of the most High and abide under Your shadow.**

2. I will say of *You* Lord: You are my refuge, my fortress, my God; in You will I trust.

3. Surely, You shall deliver me from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

4. You will cover me with Your feathers, and under Your wings shalt I trust: Your truth shall be my shield and buckler.

**5. I shall not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flies by day;**

6. Nor for the pestilence that walks in darkness; nor for the destruction that wastes at noonday.

7. A thousand shall fall at my side, and ten thousand at my right hand; but it shall not come nigh me.

**8. Only with my eyes shall I behold and see the reward of the wicked.**

9. Because I have made the **LORD**, which is my refuge, even the most High, my habitation;

10. There shall no evil befall me, neither shall any plague come nigh my dwelling.

**11. For You shall give Your angels charge over me, to keep me in all Your ways.**

12. They shall bear me up in their hands, lest I dash my foot against a stone.

13. I shall tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shall I trample under feet.

**14. Because I have set my love upon You, therefore will You deliver me: You will set me on high, because I know Your name.**

15. I shall call upon You, and You will answer me: You will be with me in trouble; You will deliver me and honour me.

**16. With long life (*will I satisfy You*) will You satisfy me and show me Your salvation.**

**Galatians 5:1** Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

**Galatians 6:7** Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man sows, that shall he also reap.

**Romans 6:11-13** Likewise reckon you also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

**1 Peter 5:8** Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking whom he may devour:

**James 4:7** Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

**2 Corinthians 2:10&11** To whom you forgive anything, I forgive also: for if I forgave anything, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ; *so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes.*

**2 Corinthians 11:13&14** For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. No wonder, *for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.*

# My Confession is I Trust in You Lord!

**Psalm 5:11** But let all those that put their trust in You rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them: let them also that love Your name be joyful in You.

**Psalm 7:1** Oh LORD my God, in you do I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and deliver me:

**Psalm 9:10** And they that know Your name will put their trust in you: for You, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek You.

**Psalm 11:1** In the LORD put I my trust: how say you to my soul, Flee as a bird to your mountain?

**Psalm 16:1** Preserve me, O God: for in You do I put my trust.

**Psalm 17:7** Show Your marvellous lovingkindness, Oh You that saves by Your right hand them which put their trust in You from those that rise up against them.

**Psalm 18:2** The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.

**Psalm 18:30** As for God, His way is perfect: the Word of the LORD is tried: He is a buckler to all those that trust in Him.

**Psalm 20:7** Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.

**Psalm 25:2** Oh my God, I trust in You: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.

**Psalm 25:20** Oh keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in You.

**Psalm 31:1** In You, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in Your righteousness.

**Psalm 31:19** Oh how great is Your goodness, which You hast laid up for them that fear you; which You hast wrought for them that trust in You before the sons of men!

**Psalm 34:22** The LORD redeems the soul of His servants: and none of them that trust in Him shall be desolate.

**Psalm 36:7** How excellent is Your lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings.

**Psalm 37:3** Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shall you dwell in the land, and verily you shall be fed.

**Psalm 37:5** Commit Your way unto the LORD; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.

**Psalm 37:40** And the LORD shall help them, and deliver them: He shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in Him.

**Psalm 40:3** And He hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

**Psalm 40:4** Blessed is that man that makes the LORD his trust, and respects not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

**Psalm 44:6** For I will not trust in my bow, neither shall my sword save me.

**Psalm 52:8** But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.

**Psalm 56:3 What time I am afraid, I will trust in You.**

**Psalm 56:4** In God I will praise His word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.

**Psalm 56:11** In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.

**Psalm 61:4** I will abide in Your tabernacle for ever: I will trust in the covert of Your wings. Selah.

**Psalm 62:8** Trust in Him at all times; you people, pour out your heart before Him: God is a refuge for us. Selah.

**Psalm 71:1 In you, O LORD, do I put my trust: let me never be put to confusion.**

**Psalm 71:5** For You art my hope, O Lord GOD: You art my trust from my youth.

**Psalm 73:28** But it is good for me to draw near to God: I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all Your works.

**Psalm 84:11 For the Lord God is a sun and shield: the Lord will give grace and glory: no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly.**

**Psalm 91:2** I will say of the LORD, You are my refuge and my fortress: my God; in You will I trust.

**Psalm 91:4** He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings shall you trust: His truth shall be Your shield and buckler.

**Psalm 115:9** Oh Israel, trust you in the LORD: He is their help and their shield.

**Psalm 115:11** You that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: He is their help and their shield.

**Psalm 118:8 It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man. than to put confidence in princes.**

**Psalm 119:42** So shall I have wherewith to answer him that reproaches me: for I trust in Your Word.

**Psalm 125:1** They that trust in the LORD shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abides forever.

**Psalm 141:8** But mine eyes are unto You, O GOD the Lord: in You is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.

**Psalm 143:8** Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning; for in You do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto You.

**Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not unto your own understanding.**

**Proverbs 3:6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.**

## **2Thessalonians:**

### **Chapter 2**

**1. Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto Him,**

*2. That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.*

**3. Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;**

**4. Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sits in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.**

**5. Remember you not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?**

**6. And now you know what withhold that he might be revealed in his time.**

*7. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now lets will let, until he be taken out of the way.*

**8. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of His mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of His coming:**

**9. Even him, who's coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,**

**10. And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.**

**11. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:**

**12. That they all might be damned who believed not the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.**

**13. But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:**

**14. Whereunto He called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**15. Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which you have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.**

**16. Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God, even our Father, which has loved us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,**

**17. Comfort your hearts and stablish you in every good word and work.**

### **Chapter 3.**

**1 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:**

**2. And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith.**

**3. But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil.**

**4. And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that you both do and will do the things which we command you.**

**5. And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.**
